

2025 CB TOUR Championship Tournament Information

Prize Fund and Entry Fees

- **First Place:** \$3,000
 - **Entry Fee:** \$165 (Break down available at below)
 - Payment Options: Cash, Check (made out to "Championship Bowling"), or Venmo (@chayton-petersen)
 - **Reentry Fee:** \$110
-

Divisions and Format

- **Divisions:**
 - **Open Division**
 - **Under Division** (For bowlers with an average of 205 or below, or a CB TOUR average of 188 or under)
 - **High Woman Out of the Cut** (highest non nationally touring woman who is not currently in the cut will make the cashers round)
 - **Format:**
 - **1 in 6 bowlers** from each division will advance to the **Cashers Round**.
 - **Sunday Cashers Round:** 4 games.
 - Cut to **Top 16** for the bracket finals if there are 23 or fewer cashers.
 - **Top 4 bowlers:** 2-round bye.
 - **Seeds 5-8:** 1-round bye.
 - If there are **24 or more cashers:** Cut to top 24. Seeds 1-8 get a 1-round bye.

Qualifying Rounds

- **Games:** Bowlers will bowl 5 games across 5 pairs of lanes per squad.
 - **Reentry:** Bowlers can reenter, and their **highest qualifying score** will carry over to the Cashers Round.
 - **Advancement:** 1 in 6 bowlers from each division will move to the Cashers Round.
 - **Average Determination:** Bowlers will use their CB TOUR average to determine eligibility for the Under Division.
 - If no CB TOUR average is available (minimum of 15 games), the bowler's **highest USBC composite average from 2023-2024** will be used.

Cashers Round Rules

- **Carryover:** The highest qualifying score will carry over to the Cashers Round.
 - **Advancement:** The top 16 or 24 bowlers (depending on the number of cashers) will be seeded into the bracket finals.
 - **Tiebreakers:** For ties for 24th and 25th position a **3 shot shootout** will be used, for all other ties within the advancers, the highest single game bowled during cashers round will break the tie.
 - The bowler with the highest single game in the Cashers Round will have lane choice and decide who finishes first in the 3 shot shootout

Bracket Finals

- **Format:** Top 16 or 24 bowlers will compete in a best-of-two-games format.
 - **Lane Choice:** High seed gets lane choice and decides the order of bowling.
 - **Practice Times:**
 - **16 bowler bracket:**
 - 10 minutes before Round 1
 - 4 minutes before Rounds 2 and 3
 - 2 shots per lane in Rounds 4 and 5
 - **24 bowler bracket:**
 - 10 minutes before Round 1
 - 5 minutes before Rounds 2
 - 2 shots per lane in Rounds 3, 4, and 5
 - **Lane Maintenance:** Lanes will be reconditioned before the start of the bracket.

New Roll-Off Format: Exciting Shootout Rules for Ties

To make tie-breaking even more thrilling, we're introducing a **3-shot shootout** format for bracket ties, inspired by hockey's overtime shootouts. Here's how it works:

- Each bowler gets **3 shots**, alternating turns.
- **Scoring:**
 - A strike earns **1 point**.
 - Any other result earns **0 points**.
- The bowler with the most points after 3 shots wins the roll-off.

If the score is tied after 3 shots, the tie is broken with a **1-ball high-count sudden death roll-off**, where the highest pinfall wins.

CB TOUR Doubles Format Overview

1. Crossover Doubles

- **Entry Fee:** \$10 per bowler, paid in full before the first bowler in the team bowls.
- **Format:** Pick as many partners as you want. Your partner must bowl the same squad as you.

2. CB Doubles Shootout

- **Entry Fee:** \$50 per bowler, paid in full before the first bowler bowls.
- **Format:** Partner with one other bowler. The top 4 teams advance to a **Baker-style bracket** immediately following the final qualifying squad.
- **Rules for Teams:**
 - Teams inside the cut can only bowl with their original partner.
 - Teams outside the cut may bowl with the same or a different partner.
 - Teams can choose to use reentry scores if they pay an extra \$50 per bowler. (Bowler 1 can reenter and pay just their \$50 and use their highest score while bowler 2 uses their 1 squad.)

3. Qualifying Scores:

- Both Crossover Doubles and CB Doubles Shootout will use main event qualifying scores.

Payment Details

- **Payment Options:**
 - Cash, check (made out to "Championship Bowling"), or Venmo (@chayton-petersen).
 - Payment can be made up to one week before the event. After this period, only cash is accepted.

Breakdown of Entry Fee (\$165):

- SNWT Points: \$5
- Expenses: \$10
- CB TOUR Points: \$10
- **Lineage:** \$30 (updated from \$25)
- Prize Fund: \$110

Side Action Opportunities

Brackets

- **Entry Fee:** \$5 per bracket
 - **Options:** Scratch and Handicap
 - All divisions combined on a squad, handicap is 75% of 220, same as challenge division. All bowlers eligible for all brackets (Except Youth)

High Game Pot

- **Entry Fee:** \$5 per game, \$25 for the squad
 - **Format:** Scratch
 - Prize awarded to the highest single-game score in each qualifying game.
-

Eliminator

- **Entry Fee:** \$10 for the set
 - **Format:** After each game, a percentage of the field is eliminated based on scores for that game.
 - The last bowler standing takes the prize.

50 Clean Pot

- **Entry Fee:** \$2
 - **Format:** Bowl a clean set of 5 games (no open frames).
 - **Current Pot:** \$450
 - Hit pays **50%** of the pot: \$225.

Prize Fund and Entry Fees

- **First Place:** \$400 (based on 80 full entries)
- **Top 2 Bowlers:** Free entry to a CB TOUR event
- **Entry Fee:** \$80
- **Reentry Fee:** \$80

- **CB TOUR Championship Series Add-On:** \$55
 - **Payment Options:** Cash, Check (made out to "Championship Bowling"), or Venmo (@chayton-petersen)

Handicap and Averages

- **Handicap:** 75% of 220
 - **Bowlers' Averages:**

Bowlers will use their CB TOUR average. If no CB TOUR average is available, the bowler's highest composite USBC average from the most recent season (minimum of 21 games) will be used.

 - For bowlers with "Sport" or "Challenge" averages, the USBC's conversion chart will be applied to convert to a standard average.
 - This converted average will then be reduced by 18 pins to establish a CB TOUR average.

Tournament Format

- **Cashers:** 1 in 4 entries will cash.
 - **Beat the Board Format:** The highest scores across all qualifying squads will determine winners.
 - **Qualifying:**
 - 5 games bowled across 5 different pairs of lanes per squad.
 - Bowlers may reenter, and their highest score will be used for cashing and awards.
-

Competition Conditions

- **Lane Conditions:** Bowlers will bowl on the same lane patterns as the main CB TOUR event.
 - **Crossing:** Challenge Series bowlers will cross lanes with main event bowlers, and all CB TOUR playing rules apply.
 - **Handicap Brackets:** Available during the CB TOUR event.

Scholarships and Entry Fees

- **Top 2 Boys and Top 2 Girls:** Guaranteed scholarship awards.
 - **Entry Fee:** \$60
 - **Reentry Fee:** \$60
 - **Payment Options:** Cash, Check (made out to "Championship Bowling"), or Venmo (@chayton-petersen)

Tournament Format

- **Cashers:** 1 in 4 entries will cash.
 - If a youth bowler qualifies for the main event cut, the next highest youth bowler in the standings will earn the scholarship.
 - **Format:** Scratch tournament (no handicap), using the "Beat the Board" format. Bowlers' scores are totaled over all qualifying rounds, and the highest totals determine the winners.
 - **Top 2 Boys and Top 2 Girls:** The highest finishing youth bowlers (boys and girls) are guaranteed to cash.
-

Qualifying

- **Games:** 5 games across 5 pairs of lanes per squad.
 - **Reentry:** Bowlers may reenter, and their highest qualifying score will be used.

Competition Conditions

- **Lane Conditions:** Junior bowlers will bowl on the same lane patterns as the main CB TOUR event.
